

Avon Track and Field League: GDPR Draft Statement

1. The Secretary of the Avon Track and Field League holds e-mail addresses of contacts of member teams, Officers of the League, Technical Officials actually or potentially available to officiate, and other activists connected with the League. Anyone on the circulation list may request at any time to be removed from the list, or to be 'blind-copied'.
2. The Results Processor will require the following information from each of the competing teams of any competitor or potential competitor for their team, updated in advance of every league fixture:

... Name and forename

... Gender

... Age as at midnight 31st August / 1st September in the year of competition

... (if required by future rules for Under-13's and upwards: EA Registration number or equivalent)

This data will be used in producing match results, which will be passed to the member teams, published on the League's website, and to Power Of 10.

The Results Processor may also request dates of birth:

... to confirm that an athlete is competing in the correct age group

... to confirm when a Senior athlete becomes eligible for Masters competition (unlike for younger age groups, this will be the athlete's age on the day of the competition)

The League will require that, under GDPR conditions, each club has obtained the appropriate permission from each of their athletes (or their parent / guardian where applicable) for the release of the above data to the Avon Track and Field League.

The personal data described above will not be released to any commercial organisation or to any other person. The data will be retained until the end of the following season, after which it will be deleted (an individual's data can be deleted earlier on request).
